Chapter One

The God Symbiont Gene

We have all seen him

What if you discovered a genetic key that could unlock and transform your DNA and make you superhuman: a genetic code so explosive yet so simple that the power to prosperity, health, joy, happiness, and the prevention of diseases could be yours? What would you do with it?

There is no need to wait anymore for there is evidence of an ancient art which geneticists and linguists are discovering, a whole new type of medicine in which the words of your mouth can influence DNA. Yes, they discovered that DNA can be improved and reprogrammed *without* cutting out and replacing single genes but by words proceeding out of your mouth and frequencies, creating exactly what your heart desires. I call this ability **The God Symbiont Gene**.

It is this God gene that biblical giants like Joshua used to stop the Earth from rotating around the sun for what seemed like a whole day. This God gene caused Philip to appear in far and distant areas in seconds at speed far beyond the speed of light and even that of thought. It is the same genetic makeup Elijah used to part the waters of Jordan and cross it on dry ground. This is the

power Jesus Christ used to walk on water as if it were concrete, ignoring the concepts of viscosity and shattering to pieces the laws of molecular density.

This God Symbiont Gene is available for you and has been for years. It can make a mere human superhuman. It grants a person the ability to perform superhuman feats that will shock their world. Human strength like that of Eleazar son of Dodai the Ahohite recorded in biblical text is possible when one gets a hold of the secret of transforming their DNA using this coding as Eleazar did. He was one of the three mighty men who were with David when they taunted the Philistines gathered at Pas Dammim for battle. As the enemy advanced and the men of Israel retreated, Eleazar stood his ground and struck down an estimated one thousand Philistines singlehandedly. He fought until his hand grew tired and froze to the sword. By the time the troops returned, the only thing left for them to do was to strip the dead. Eleazar had already done all the fighting (see 2 Samuel 23:9–10).

Another carrier of the God Symbiont Gene was Shammah son of Agee the Hararite. He stood his ground against a troop of Philistine soldiers who had banded together at a field full of lentils. The estimated number of soldiers in the troop is between eight hundred to one thousand. Israel's troops fled from the Philistines, but Shammah took his stand in the middle of the field and defended it, striking the Philistines down by himself (2 Samuel 23:11–12).

We also have Benaiah, son of Jehoiada whose father was a valiant fighter from Kabzeel who performed great exploits. Benaiah struck down two of Moab's best fighting men (1 Chronicles 11:22a). He also went down into a pit on a snowy day and killed a lion with one slap to its face (1 Chronicles 11:22b). Imagine killing a lion with your bare hands! And this was not just any lion. This was a lion that was trapped in a pit without food on a cold, snowy day, which increased the likelihood of the lion being even more hungry and aggressive. Suffice it to say that a hungry lion is a ferocious beast. The safest way to kill it would have been from above, but Benaiah went down into the pit, faced it head-on, and with one clap killed it with superhuman strength. The God Symbiont Gene was fully activated in these men!

Why I Call It the God Symbiont Gene

The word symbiont is derived from the word symbiosis, which in biology is the living together of two dissimilar or different organisms. In a symbiotic relationship, each of the organisms may benefit (mutualism), or one may benefit without affecting the other (commensalism), or one is destroyed and the other is unaffected (amensalism), or one benefits at the expense of the other (parasitism). In psychiatry, symbiosis is a beneficial or detrimental relationship between two people in which each person is dependent upon and receives reinforcement from the other. In psychoanalysis, it is the relationship between an infant who is dependent on its mother both physically and emotionally. In a nutshell, symbiosis involves an interdependent and sometimes mutually beneficial relationship between two persons, groups, or things. Let me try and illustrate in layman's terms what symbiosis or the God Symbiont Gene does by refreshing your memory of the fictional character that took the word symbiosis to a level close to what I am describing: Spider-Man.

Introducing the Symbiote

The Amazing Spider-Man movies introduced the concept called Symbiotes. They appear in *The Amazing Spider-Man*, *The Spectacular Spider-Man*, and *Marvel Team-Up* in which Spider-Man brings a Symbiote home to Earth after the Secret Wars. Symbiotes exist in the Marvel Comics shared universe as a fictional race of amorphous extra-terrestrial parasites that envelop their hosts like costumes, thus creating a symbiotic bond used to influence the mind of the host.

These Symbiotes, as depicted in the movie, empower a host to the point where the natural abilities of the host far exceed that of normal members of the hosts' species. These abilities include superhuman strength, speed, endurance, agility, healing capabilities, superior intelligence, and other enhanced natural attributes as well. The Symbiotes also give the host genetic memory, giving them the ability to recall information gathered from previous hosts. Symbiotes can negate the damage caused by terminal illnesses and permanent injuries. They can also expand to any size as long as they have a host or object to grow on. Symbiotes can get inside small areas such as electric wires or the mechanical components of cars and even disable them altogether. Here's where things get even more intriguing. The Symbiote also

reacts to the thoughts and will of the host. For example, when Spider-Man was initially selected, he had been thinking about Spider-Woman's costume in the *Secret Wars*. The Symbiote acted on Spider-Man's thoughts and formed a similar costume, the one we see Spider-Man wearing. And finally, *the Symbiote reacts to the words of its host*.

The Real Symbiote

What I am trying to explain to you and show you in this book is that there is such a thing as a symbiotic coexistence between you and God Himself. Once you understand how to take advantage of this divine symbiosis, you will be able to do exploits that will make The Amazing Spider-Man seem like nothing more than a toy on a shelf. The God Symbiote Gene can make an amazing wonder out of you!

Now, when we talk about symbiosis, it is available in a greater measure in this natural world. And when functioning at a high level, it can positively reprogram your DNA. It is a mindblowing advantageous coexistence between the mortal and the immortal that causes superhuman strength to envelop you as the host of the Divine Symbiote. In simple terms, it transfers to you the God Symbiont Gene that transforms a mere man into a supernatural man. And with it, you can transcend and operate outside the boundary of time itself.

Moses, the biblical Old Testament stuttering prophet got a rub off from this genome and tapped into its power. So much so that when he reached 120 years of age, he testified that he was still as strong as he was when he was a young man. Moses' eyes were not dim, and his force (strength) was not abated. He was getting stronger by the year. In fact, God Himself had to remind Moses to die.

Deuteronomy 32:49-50

Get thee... to mount Nebo... And die [emphasis added].

Imagine what you would do if death were no longer an issue; you had to be reminded to die because even at 120, you were still as fit as a teenager. With the power plugged into this God Symbiont Gene within Moses, this man was going to keep on living. He had to be reminded to check out of this earth.

That's just a fraction of what this divine genome can do for you and me.

I am not just writing theory; I know what I am talking about from experience. I have seen it work, and I have moved into it myself. I am a witness to this God Symbiont Gene as I have experienced it many times. You see, I have levitated with no special effects, created things and multiplied food from thin air, travelled distances of miles upon miles in a second, appeared in two places simultaneously and done many things that can only be described as alien or foreign to our earthly human nature. Such things are possible, and as I always say, a man with an experience is not at the mercy of a man with a mere argument. These things are more than possible to the ones surnamed with Christ. Let me show you what you're truly made up of.

Genetics and the DNA

Since the title of this book is the Genetics of Words, you need to understand something about genetics as it relates to what we're talking about. So, let's do a quick introduction or refresher as the case may be.

Your body is made up of cells. Each cell makes up different tissues, and all the tissues together construct your physical body. Every single cell in your body contains DNA. You can think of DNA as the instruction manual for all of your cells. It carries all the information about how a living thing looks and functions. The actual instructions within the DNA are called genes, and a gene tells a cell how to make a specific protein. So, DNA tells cells what proteins to make, and proteins tell each cell what to do. Are you getting it?

Now, of all the DNA in your body, only ten per cent of it is used for building proteins. This subset of DNA is what Western researchers examine and categorize. They consider the other ninety per cent that does not contain instructions for proteins "junk DNA." However, Russian researchers who were convinced that "junk DNA" is worthy of further examination joined linguists and geneticists in an effort to explore this so-called "junk DNA." Instead of junk, they found treasure. According to them, DNA is not only responsible for the construction of your body but also serves as data storage and plays a significant role in communication. Stay with me here because it's important that you understand how this thing actually works. That is the only way you will be able to consistently achieve results from it.

The Language of DNA

Russian linguists discovered that the genetic code, especially in the “junk DNA,” follows the same rules as all our human languages. They compared the rules of syntax (the way words are put together to form phrases and sentences). They looked at semantics (the study of meaning in language) along with the basic rules of grammar. They found that the components of our DNA follow a regular grammar and have set rules just like our natural languages. It also shows that the components of DNA are themselves a result of a language form. That means human languages did not appear coincidentally but are a reflection of what’s already inside our DNA. In other words, your ability to speak a language comes from your DNA’s ability to “speak” a language.

In 2000, at the culmination of an international DNA research project led by geneticist Francis Collins and more than a decade in the making, a globally televised press conference was held at the White House. With a global audience watching, a statement was made that would grab the world’s attention and forever change how we viewed our humanity. An almost reverend silence filled the briefing room; not even the shutter of a camera lens could be heard. It was as if the people stilled themselves, bracing in anticipation of the impact of what was about to be said. Then in a voice of quiet triumph, President Clinton echoed the words of Dr Collins, words that would transform our understanding of everything.

“Today, we are learning the language in which God created life.”
After years of rigorous research, Dr Collins had discovered the language of God!

You Were Born with It

With all their scientific investigation and exploratory endeavours, scientists are discovering what God told us all along. You have the DNA of God. The Bible tells us that we are born of God. Apostle John testified of this when he wrote:

John 1:12-13

12 But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the

sons of God, even to them that believe on His name: 13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God [emphasis added].

Again, he reminds us of this truth in his first epistle, where he says:

1 John 5:1

Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ *is born of God* [emphasis added].

You are born of God! There is more to you than just cells coming together to form flesh and bones. You have the DNA of God! Not only that, but He infused your very cells, your DNA, with God stuff. The Bible says we are born of the Word.

1 Peter 1:23

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of

***incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever* [emphasis added].**

When God said, “**Let us make man in our image, after our likeness,**” it was like the DNA (God) giving an instruction (the Word, Jesus) to tell the cell (the Holy Ghost) what to create. “Let us make” was not just a statement of intention. It was the formative process of creation that communicated what was in the mind of God, and that same process was replicated in you. Divine genetics was set into motion, and He did it with His words.

God speaks. He uses words to communicate what He wants to create, and whatever He says comes into being. Since we are created in His image, we also use words to communicate what we want to create. And it goes deeper than that. Your mouth is not the only thing that speaks; your very DNA speaks. You may wonder how such a thing is possible. Jesus said it this way:

John 5:26

For as the Father hath life in Himself; so hath He given to the Son to have life in Himself.

The Father has life in Himself, and the same life that is in the Father is in the Son. You are in the Son and the Son is in you. That means that same life that is in Jesus is in you. That is why Apostle John could say we are as He is.

1John 4:17

As He is, so are we in this world...

Brother, there is something in you that you have not yet realized. Sister, there is potential in you that is still untapped. There is divine life at work in you, flowing through your body, in every fibre and cell of your being! Hallelujah!

If Walls Could Talk

Everything that God creates has life in it. That is why as the people celebrated Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, He could tell His disciples, "***if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out***" (Luke 19:40). That was not just idle talk. Jesus knew exactly what He was saying. He was aware that within everything God created, there is life.

I was with my mentor and life coach, Pastor Chris, and I was privileged to hear of one of the many times Jesus personally visited him. He told me that as he sat in his office, Jesus came walking down the corridor. This was not some obscure vision of Jesus; it was Jesus Himself! At that point, while Jesus was still in the corridor, Pastor Chris could not see Him yet. But he said to me, "The walls announced His coming!" They informed him like, *Sir, Jesus is in the corridor!* He went on to explain that even the Plexiglas table in front of him had life in it, the life that comes from God. But it takes someone who understands how the God Symbiont Gene works to provoke a reaction. Hallelujah!

I boldly submit to you that everything created by God has life in it. The limitations of the natural scientific mind are too minuscule to place any restrictions on the God who gives scientists what to discover. Scientists may not have discovered how to verify that rocks (or walls) can cry out, but that does not mean that it can't happen. It can, and it did! Scientists also may not know how to prove a man being able to walk on water, but that doesn't mean it is not possible. We know from the Word it is possible, and we're not talking about using tricks of illusion or non-Newtonian fluids. We're talking

about a man, the man Christ Jesus and even Peter, walking on water.

DNA is known as the language of life. Where do you think that language came from? It came from God! Nothing exists without His life being imparted to it. According to 1 John 4:4, we are of God. In other words, we are His offspring, which means the life God has is also imparted to us.

1 John 4:4

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them.

The Greek word translated as ‘children’ is teknon, and it means offspring. Since we are God’s offspring created in His image and likeness, His ability becomes our ability. He passed it on to us. It’s in our spiritual DNA, and that spiritual DNA can affect our physical DNA and everything around us.

His Word gives birth to words in us, and He has given our DNA the ability to communicate with and respond to words that are on the God frequency. What do I mean by the God frequency? It’s the God Symbiont Gene at work, and the key to activating it is closer to you than you think.

Chapter Two

Enlightened DNA

God operates on His own frequency. Everything He is, does, says, and creates functions according to that frequency. To begin to understand what that frequency is and how it operates, we need to go back to the beginning, not Genesis, but the book that sets the stage for Genesis chapter 1.

The book of John tells us the beginning of God. Now, when I use the word “beginning” here, I’m using it only as a frame of reference. “Beginning” is a measurement of time, and God is the creator of time. Therefore, He cannot be measured or defined by it. So, when I speak of the “beginning” of God, I am simply providing a frame of reference.

In the first chapter of John, the opening verses allude to the frequency of God. I’m referring to verses 1 to 4 which read as follows:

John 1:1-4

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.

I want to draw your attention to verses 3 and 4. We saw in the previous chapter that absolutely nothing exists without the life of God imparted to it. Verse 3 of John chapter 1 concurs by telling us that everything that was made was made “by” Him.

Now, when we see the word ‘by’ in English, it frames the verse in the context of everything being created *by* God. But that word translated ‘by’ comes from the Greek word *diá*, which also means *from*. So, we could read verse 3 as follows:

John 1:3

All things were made *from* Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made.

From that context, we understand that everything that was made was made from the same stuff God is made of. Verse 4 then gives us insight into what that “stuff” is: “**In Him was *life*; and *the life was the light of men*.**” That means the life of God is light. In other words, light is the stuff God is made of.

Light and Sound

Light is more than just something that must enter your eyes so that you can see. According to scientists, light is the smallest quantity of energy that can be transported. Light interacts with matter and is also altered by it. Light can travel through space and air. Light can be used to gather information about the world around it with almost no delay. Light in a vacuum travels at *C*, that is 299,792,458 meters per second (or 186,282 miles per second); that's one billion kilometres per hour (or 670,616,629 miles per hour). Those are staggering numbers to wrap your mind around so don't get hung up on these! Just stay with me as I explain.

To give you an idea of how fast that is, let me put it another way. Light travels so fast that it takes a little over a second for light to go from the moon to the Earth. In the same distance from the Earth to the moon, you could travel from London to New York City sixty-nine times, and light does it in about a second! So, when you read in Genesis 1:3 where God said, “**Let there be light,**” He released energy that could travel at an astounding speed, carry information, and interact with matter.

Now, matter is defined as anything that has mass and takes up space. Light itself has no mass, yet it can affect anything that has mass and takes up space. Everything is made of matter. The book you are holding right now or the device you're reading it on is made of matter. You are made of matter; your DNA is made of matter. That means light and what it transmits can affect everything, including DNA.

That is a biblical truth that has been proven by scientists who don't even have the revelation of God. Russian biophysicist and molecular biologist Pjotr Garjajev was one such scientist. He along with his colleagues explored the vibrational behaviour of DNA. When I use the term 'vibrational behaviour,' I do not mean that they got some DNA samples and shook them around to see how much they might vibrate. Vibration simply refers to a change that keeps happening over and over again when energy hits it.

For example, musical instruments rely entirely on vibration to make sound. When you pluck, strike, or blow into an instrument, that creates a vibration, and each vibration has a frequency. When you speak, air passes over your vocal cords and causes them to vibrate. That is what produces sound when you talk or sing. The higher the rate of vibration (or frequency), the higher the pitch will be. In short, sound has a frequency and DNA also has a frequency.

In physics, sound is a vibration. I don't want to lose you here, so you need to follow this closely. What these scientists managed to do was modulate certain frequency patterns (sound) onto a laser ray (light). They then used that light that was carrying sound to influence the DNA frequency and consequently the genetic information itself. Taking the findings of that experiment a step further, they were able to prove that living DNA—that is DNA found in living tissue, not in vitro (in a test tube)—always reacts to language-

modulated laser rays (light) as long as the proper frequencies are used.

That was an astounding discovery because that means that you can talk to DNA using light and sound. What's more, since DNA follows grammar and set rules like our natural languages, no DNA decoding is necessary. In other words, no translation from our natural language is required for the DNA to understand it. You can use words and sentences of the human language as long as they are on the right frequencies! All this is scientific facts proven in the laboratory. Now we are about to connect the same science with the reality and truth of God's Word.

Light and Shadow

According to the scriptures, you are born of God, made from the same fabric, as it were. You have the light of God in you because God is light.

1 John 1:5

This then is the message which we have heard of Him, and declare unto you, that *God is light* [emphasis added], and in Him is no darkness at all.

Since God is light, whatever He gives birth to is also light. Jesus told us this, but many Christians have failed to grasp the truth of it. He defines us by who He is.

1 John 4:17

As He is, so are we in this world.

So, when you want to understand who and what you are, look at Jesus. When you know who and what Jesus is, then you'll know exactly who you are. He tells you first that He Himself is light so that will know what His divine genome has passed on to you. Look at what He says in John chapter 8 verse 12:

John 8:12

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

Do you see that? He is light, and because of that, anyone in His spiritual bloodline that has His DNA also has the light of life. You have it. As a matter of fact, you *are* it. That's what the Bible says.

Matthew 5:14

You are the light of the world.

Just as He is the light, you are the light. You have inherited His genetic makeup, and He has transferred His DNA information in its entirety directly to you. When Jesus said you are the light of the world, He was not only talking about your influence or effect in the world. He is saying you *are* light. You might look at yourself and wonder how is this possible since you're looking at what appears to be a solid physical body. But your physical body is an illusion. It is not what it appears to be. Let me explain.

A shadow is what is created or cast when something comes between light and a surface. That is what your body is: a shadow of you, the real you. When you touch your physical body, it's your brain that sends signals that make you believe you're touching something solid. Even if you look at it from a purely biological perspective, you are a conglomeration of cells assembled with such expert design and intricacy that you can't tell one cell apart from the other. To your eyes, you are one single body. You cannot detect with your natural eyes the thirty to forty trillion cells which compose your body. And each one of those cells is filled with the light of life.

The discovery that light can be used to transmit sound which can alter DNA gives us a convincing scientific explanation of why affirmations, autogenous training (a technique that teaches your body to respond to verbal commands). All of these techniques involve words. It is entirely normal and natural for our DNA to react to language. And for us as Christians, this has an even more significant spiritual impact.

Russian researchers used this breakthrough knowledge to focus on the development of devices that can influence cellular metabolism through suitable modulated radio and light frequencies and thus repair genetic defects. The hope and promise of understanding this language of God and applying this knowledge to the development of powerful new tools is becoming a reality.

Garjajev's research group succeeded in proving that with this method chromosomes damaged by x-rays, for example, can be repaired. While western researchers were busy cutting single genes from DNA strands to insert them elsewhere, Garjajev's group successfully captured information patterns of a particular DNA and transmitted it onto another, consequently reprogramming cells to another genome. For example, they transformed frog embryos to salamander embryos by transmitting the DNA information patterns. Did you catch that? They changed one species of being to another species of being by transmitting DNA. This method allowed them to transfer the DNA information in its entirety without encountering any of the adverse side effects of cutting out and re-introducing single genes from the DNA. Applying vibration and language instead of the antiquated cutting-out of individual genes is a revolutionary and world-transforming concept that makes the entirety of the DNA system available and directly controllable.

Words of Light and Life

Scientists need to develop devices to transmit light at the right frequencies to affect genetic makeup. But you don't need any man-made device to transmit light. You *are* light, and your mouth is the only device you need. What's more, you have access to words that are guaranteed to operate at the same frequency as the frequency of your DNA. It's called the Word of God. The Bible says:

Psalm 119:130

The entrance of Thy words giveth light.

This is not a metaphor or a simile. The scripture is not saying the word is *like* light. The Word of God *is* light. And "words" here is referring specifically to words that are *spoken*. The Hebrew word is *dabar* and it means *speech, utterance, sayings*. It's the same word used in Proverbs 4 where it says:

Proverbs 4:20-22

20 My son, attend to my words [*dabar*]; incline thine ear unto my sayings [emphasis added]. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22

For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh

[emphasis added].

This is reminiscent of what Jesus said when He declared, “ **I am the light of the world: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.**” (John 8:12). This light gives life, and the Word spoken (*dabar*) is life. Therefore, when you speak His word, you transfer the light which gives life.

Words have vibrational frequency and are transferred by light. Scientifically we have seen how this can be accomplished in an observable way. Also, when you speak, you transmit light. But it’s important for you to keep in mind that there are all kinds of light.

Jesus made an interesting statement that is of note, particularly in the context of what we’re talking about. Look at what He said in Matthew chapter 6:

Matthew 6:22-23

22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. 23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!

Many people don’t understand that darkness itself is also light, it’s just a negative form of light. If you were to say, “if the car in your garage be a Mercedes,” you understand that a Mercedes is a kind of car. In the same way, when the scripture says, “**if the light in you be darkness,**” you understand that darkness is a kind of light.

With that understanding in mind, the Bible tells us that when we speak, our words produce something. Proverbs 18 tells us that death and life are in the power of the tongue.

Proverbs 18:21

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

That means that the words you speak transmit light, and that light is producing life or death, light or darkness. If you speak negative words—

words of hatred, gossip, guilt, and the like—the light you transmit will be darkness and produce death. Those are words that are devoid of the truth of God, infused with ignorance and permeated with foolishness. Such words bring darkness, and that darkness will affect your whole body. But when you speak the Word of God, the light of life flows affecting everything about you.

Everything in you is designed to respond to the frequency of God's Word. His Word is full of life and divine energy, and it has inherent power to produce what it says. That's what the Bible means when it says the Word of God is quick and powerful.

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Especially like how the Amplified version says it:

For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective, emphasis added]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analysing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart.

The Word is full of energy. When you speak it, you are speaking words that are alive and full of power, making that *dabar* active, operative, energizing, and effective. When you, the light of God, speak such words, you transmit light more powerful and precise than any laser and are charged with the frequency of God. Those words spoken out of your mouth can penetrate and change anything. Scientists used to believe that atoms were the smallest particle of matter. Now they are saying that quarks and leptons are smaller. But it doesn't matter how minute the particle of matter is, the Word of God can get in there and cause changes!

There is such a thing in scriptures as greater light and lesser light. You are light, yet you have the capacity to become an even greater light. You already

have the light of God in you; it's part of your biological and spiritual DNA. But that light can be increased. The more of the Word you have in you, the greater your light becomes because the entrance of His Word gives light. As you speak the words that are on the same frequency as God's Word, those words will be communicated to your DNA, and you will change your world from the inside out.

Remember, communicating at the right frequency is key. But before you can modulate to God's frequency, I had to show you precisely what it is you should be transmitting. You now know the material or sound or vibration of choice is the Word of God. Now I am going to show you how to modulate to the God frequency.

Chapter Three

The God Frequency

The most important thing God ever gave you was words. He gave you words before He gave you salvation, and everything you have or ever will receive from Him is predicated on words. Without words, you could not receive salvation because salvation is given to you through words and received with words. The Bible tells us that to be saved, you must call upon the name of the Lord:

Romans 10:13

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

But notice the process that makes that possible:

Romans 10:14

How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

Salvation is communicated to you through words, and then with your words, you receive it. That is what the scripture says in Romans chapter 10:

Romans 10:8-10

8 But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Do you see that? You hear words that communicate salvation to you, then you speak or confess words affirming your belief in that salvation. That is the system God has set in place for all of us to receive salvation. It is a system of words. That is the way God operates: He speaks words to communicate His thoughts, intent, will, and promises.

The Creative Word

God is a speaking God, and when He speaks a word, that word contains the inherent ability to produce what it says. His words have creative ability, and He has given us the same ability to speak words that create.

He told us in His Word that our words—every word we speak—creates or produces something.

Proverbs 18:21

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

The power of the tongue is your words, your ability to speak things into existence. Your life right now is the result of words spoken, and you chart the course of your life with your words.

James draws an analogy between the tongue and instruments used to control the direction of things. He compares the tongue to the bit of a horses bridle.

James 3:3

Behold, we put bits in the horses’ mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.

Now, a bit is a small device about five inches long that is attached to a

horse's bridle. The bit is the part of the bridle that goes into the horse's mouth. Horses are not small creatures by any stretch of the imagination. A full-grown horse on average can weigh more than 500 kilograms (over 1200 pounds). Yet, this tiny bit can control the horse's speed and direction of movement.

James also compares the tongue to the rudder of a ship.

James 3:4-5a

4 Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth. 5 Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things.

A ship is classified as any boat that is more than 60 meters (nearly 200 feet) long and weighs more than 500 tonnes. A ship's rudder is incomparably smaller than the ship itself but is used to steer a vessel of immense proportions.

With your tongue, more specifically, your words, you steer or chart the course of your life. As a prophet, my words are my greatest asset. You may not be a prophet, but as a Christian, you ought to recognize that words are also your greatest asset. Words were given to you so that you can grab the reigns of your life and steer your life in the direction you want it to go. But too often, Christians have spoken words to their detriment rather than their benefit.

There was a woman who went to her doctor complaining that she felt hot all the time. The doctor ran all kinds of tests trying to determine what was causing the problem. Every diagnostic test came back negative. But in consulting with the woman, the doctor noticed something. The woman kept saying, "I'm burning up!"

Since the tests could uncover no medical cause for her problem, the doctor gave her a simple suggestion: maybe you should stop saying, "I'm burning up!" Exasperated and left with no other recourse, the woman decided to give that a try. Every time she started to say, "I'm burning up!" she would catch herself and say, "I feel so cool." As she continued to do this, within a couple

of weeks, her high temperature normalized, and the hot flashes stopped completely.

How could such a thing happen? Was this woman lying by saying she was cool? No, not at all! She was activating a principle that God Himself uses. The Bible says:

Romans 4:17

(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were [emphasis added]).

Notice, it does not say that we should speak those things which are as though they were not. It says if we're going to function like God, we must speak those things which be not as though they were. The woman did not say she wasn't hot; she said she felt cool. She spoke those things which were not as though they were. You don't need to speak your sickness. You need to speak your healing. You don't have to talk about how broke you are. Instead, talk about how rich Christ has made you.

You see, as this woman spoke and continued to speak, her words were affecting her own body. It was the same principle she had enacted negatively by continually declaring that she was "burning up." When she used her words positively, they had a positive effect on her body.

Words and DNA

When we started Spirit Embassy, we used to meet at the Princess Street Hotel in Manchester. There were about fourteen of us attending the church at the time. We had two live potted trees inside the church, one on the left and one on the right. Every morning when we arrived for service, we would have a session where the entire church would bless the tree that was on the left: *I bless you. You shall be green. You shall increase. You shall grow tall.* But to the tree on the right, we said *you will die!* We watered them both the same way. The only thing that was different was the words we spoke to each. After about four or five weeks the tree on the right dried up while the one on the left flourished and remained green. The trees could understand our words. Within everything, even the things you think are inanimate, there is

something that came from God that He put in there, and it can respond to your words. Think about this for a moment, even when we go back to creation in the book of Genesis, the only raw material God uses to set things in motion is His word. Creation understands the spoken word because it was born of the same Word.

When you speak, you alter your DNA. We will talk more about it in the next chapter. But for now, I want you to understand that your words, and words in general, affect DNA. That is why it is crucial for you to be intentional about both the words you hear and the words you speak. James says it this way:

James 3:2

For in many things we offend all. *If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man [emphasis added], and able also to bridle the whole body.*

Maturity and how you reign in this life are measured by how you use your words. James is telling us that any person who has disciplined themselves to use their words with intentionality for advancement in life, that is a perfect or mature person of the highest degree. Such a person can control their whole body and consequently their life.

Jesus pointed out to us that words are either productive or idle. In Matthew 12, He likens us to trees that bring forth fruit based on what is in the heart.

Matthew 12:33

Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.

You might think Jesus is referring there to the actions of a person. But if you keep reading, you will see that He is talking specifically about words. Watch what He says:

Matthew 12:34-35

34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. 35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

He is telling us that what you put into your heart determines the quality of words that come out of your mouth.

In computer science, there is a well-known expression: Garbage In, Garbage Out (GIGO). It means that the quality of the code you input will determine the quality of the output. That is true of computer programming, and it is also true of you. As your words go, so your life goes. Look at what Solomon, one of the world's wisest men ever to live, said about words:

Proverbs 8:8

All the words of my mouth are in righteousness; there is nothing froward or perverse in them.

In simple words, don't talk nonsense! Many of you may find it difficult just to stop talking nonsense because you've programmed yourself for so long with nonsense. Like the woman who was overheating, it was not enough for her to only stop saying *I'm burning up*. She had to replace those words with other words that would produce the result she wanted. You must do the same.

Now, I'm about to share with you a secret my man of God and life coach, Pastor Chris, shared with me. If you catch it, I guarantee you will never speak the same way again. Even if you keep saying the same thing you've always been saying, after what I'm about to tell you, your awareness will be forever changed. Here it is. In the realm of the spirit, words are destroyed by other words. Did you catch that? I'll repeat. The only thing that can destroy or override a negative word is a positive word.

Look at what Jesus said in Matthew chapter 12:

Matthew 12:36-37

36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. 37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Every word you speak is accounted for, including the idle ones. The word for *idle* there is the Greek word, *argós* which means *lazy, useless, barren*. I don't want you to be confused right there and think that an idle word is barren in the sense that it is not producing anything. We have already seen from

Proverbs 18:21 that your words—all of them—produce something in your life. So, even an idle word is producing something.

The problem with idle words is they produce what you don't want. They are *unemployed* in the sense that they are not working to produce what they should. Your words will either be building your life up or tearing it down. They will either be working for your advantage or working against you (not working for your benefit).

The good news is, if your life is reflecting the idle words you've spoken, you can change it. That key was given to us right at the beginning of Matthew 12:33:

Matthew 12:33

Either *make the tree good* [emphasis added], and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.

You can “make the tree good.” How? By feeding your spirit with the right words. What goes in is what comes out. If you replace idle words with words of intentionality for your advancement, then your words will begin to work for you.

Words of Faith

You see, many Christians have lived a lifetime of speaking negative words, then they wonder why their lives are such a mess. The reality is you are the product of words. That is why it is essential to feed your spirit every day with the Word of God. Your spirit feeds on the Word the same way your physical body feeds on natural food. Kenneth E. Hagin, quoting F.F. Bosworth said, “Most Christians feed their body three hot meals a day and their spirit one cold snack a week. And they wonder why they're so weak in faith.” I want you to think for a moment of all the things the Bible says you need to please God. As important as love is, He never said you need love to please Him. He never said you need joy to please Him. He said you need faith to please Him. In fact, without faith, it's impossible to please God.

Hebrews 11:6a

But without faith it is impossible to please Him.

Faith is what gets you on the frequency of God. I started out by telling you that God is a speaking God. And when He speaks, His words are full of faith. If you are going to communicate on His frequency, faith is required.

Jesus was a master of communicating on the God frequency. If you take note of how Jesus—God in the body of a Jew— spoke while He was on earth, you will see that He spoke simple faith-filled words that produced results every time. Not one of His words was idle (unemployed). He was aware that His words were giving life to something in the spirit realm. That is why He said:

John 6:63b

The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

Every time He opened His mouth, He knew His words were producing something. Whether He was speaking to a shrivelled limb or the roots of a tree, He knew His words were changing things, altering DNA. This is the awareness we ought to have. In fact, He actually tells us that if we would speak faith-filled words, all things are possible.

Mark 11:23

For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass, he shall have whatsoever he saith.

This is remarkable! The Lord is telling us that the person who will speak faith-filled words can have whatever they say. Hallelujah!

I'm reminded of a time in July of 2008 when I was travelling from my then hometown of Manchester on my way to Heathrow airport. I had a flight to catch the next morning, and one of my pastors was driving us. About half an hour into the four-hour journey, it began raining so heavily that our driver could hardly see.

I remember thinking about how hazardous the driving conditions were and how I could potentially miss my flight. Immediately the words of the Lord Jesus in Mark 11:23 resounded in my spirit: "he shall have whatsoever he saith." I just pointed to the clouds and commanded the rain to stop. I'm

telling you we had not gone half a mile, and the sunshine was breaking through the clouds. Not a drop of rain fell after that. What happened? Faith-filled words! That's the frequency of God. I have done this same thing numerous times and it works every time!

We saw how scientists have proven that DNA has a frequency with which you can communicate. The key is you need to be on the same frequency. What scientists may not have fully understood yet is that the God frequency is far superior to any frequency they can observe in a lab. It is with that superior frequency we can communicate with everything around us. Faith is the frequency of God.

When you talk to Him, you must be on His frequency. When you speak the Word of God in faith over your body, over your finances, over any adverse situation, you are communicating with the God frequency. Everything in and around you is designed to respond to the frequency of God's Word because that is the frequency with which everything was created.

Hebrews 11:3

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

When you speak faith-filled words, you can move any obstacle because everything in the physical is temporal and subject to change (see 2 Corinthians 4:18). Jesus made this very clear when He said:

Matthew 17:20b

If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

When you communicate on this frequency of faith, nothing is impossible. You can speak to anything and it will respond. This is what gives me the audacity to stand in a stadium full of people, with cameras rolling while we are broadcasting around the world and command miracle money to appear in

people's pockets and bank accounts. In fact, in July of 2019 while in Uganda, we actually could not total the amount of money people received as miracle money because the queues of people testifying were that long. We just did not have enough manpower to cope. That is exactly what the Lord Jesus was teaching when He said you can have what you say. When you speak faith-filled words, you are tuning in to the frequency of God.

The God-Kind of Faith

Now before we continue, it is vital that we make a distinction here between the God-kind of faith and another type of faith which we will refer to as the human-kind of faith. The human-kind of faith sees before it believes. This was the kind of faith Thomas had.

Thomas refused to believe Jesus' resurrection unless he saw Jesus for himself. This kind of faith is limited to the physical sense realm. It doubts until it sees. But the God-kind of faith leaves no room for doubt, and it does not require any physical proof. The presence of faith itself is all the proof the God-kind of faith needs.

Hebrews 11:1

Now *faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen [emphasis added].*

Faith *is* the evidence! The presence of faith is the proof that you already have that thing you're hoping for. Faith is not trying to get something. Faith is taking possession of what you know you already have. How do you know you have it? You know you have it because you have faith for it. *Faith is the evidence!*

The question now is how does the God-kind of faith come to you? The Bible plainly tells us how faith comes to us in Romans chapter 10:

Romans 10:17

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Let me shock you a little bit. Faith does not come by hearing the Word of God. That's not what the verse says. It says faith comes by hearing, and it is

the hearing that comes by the Word of God. (Some of you will get that tomorrow.)

Suffice it to say, faith is information-based, and that information is the Word of God. Faith is not blind. Faith sees; it perceives. Faith comes by knowledge: information. If you're foolish, you can't have faith. Faith is for the intelligent. You can't have faith for something you know nothing about. Increase in knowledge of the Word, and you will increase in faith because it's the Word of God that tells you what belongs to you. Watch what the scripture says:

Hebrews 11:17-19

By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac; and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, of whom it was said, that in Isaac shall thy seed be called. Accounting that God was able also to raise him up from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

Old Abraham had some information that moved him into faith. Hallelujah! The Bible says that Abraham had already been told that it was through Isaac that he would be the father of all nations. So, when God asked him to offer up Isaac, the decision was not as difficult as you imagined. He already knew, whether he offered Isaac or not, that it was through Isaac that he would be the father of all nations. In his mind, if God had to raise him from the dead, then that is exactly what was going to happen. Faith is informationbased. It's not blind!

Using the God Frequency

Now that you know that faith is the God-frequency, how exactly do you use it to get results? The writer of Hebrews said it like this:

Hebrews 10:23

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised.

What this simply means is whatever God has said concerning your life, you agree with Him by openly declaring what He said. For example, if God says

you're rich, you open your mouth and maintain the confession that you are rich. If He tells you that you're healed, you declare that you are healed. That does not mean that if the doctor has given you a negative report about your health, you're denying the facts. No. You are merely denying the facts the authority to dictate what happens in your life. By confessing the Word over your health, you are acknowledging the truth, and the truth overrides the facts.

Hold onto your confession of faith. Don't change it. In light of and in spite of what you see, hear, or experience with your physical senses, stand flat-footed and boldly declare what the Word says is true about you. You don't even have to figure out what to say. God has made it easy for you. He has given you all the speaking material you need in His Word. He has said so that you may boldly say!

Hebrews 13:5b-6

5 For He hath said... 6 So that we may boldly say.

Openly declare whatever God says about you. Speak faithfilled words. Let them go and get your money. Let them restore your health. Use them to change that situation that is bothering you. Everything you need is wrapped up in the Word! Talk like Jesus. Speak the Word in faith, and you will come back with a testimony every time!

Chapter Four

The Environment of Words

We have already seen in the book of Hebrews from the previous chapter that God spoke faith-filled words which brought this environment which we call the world into existence. It tells us that the world was framed by the Word of God.

Hebrews 11:3

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

We, who are created in the image and likeness of God, have the DNA of God. We speak words that cause things from the spiritual realm to materialize in the physical. We also create the visible from the invisible. As we speak, we change environments.

In the scriptures, to confer a blessing upon a person, it had to be spoken. That blessing—the words spoken for the enablement and advantage of the person receiving the blessing—created an environment for prosperity, establishment, and overall well-being.

When Jacob received the blessing of the firstborn instead of his brother Esau, Isaac could not take it back. All he had done was to pronounce a blessing with words, and it was done. That blessing had already been bestowed on Jacob.

Genesis 27:37

And Isaac answered and said unto Esau, Behold, I have made him thy lord, and all his brethren have I given to him for servants; and with corn and wine have I sustained him: and what shall I do now unto thee, my son?

I hope you are getting this. These brothers were never consulted about being made the servants of Jacob through that blessing. They were never asked *are you ok serving your brother because I'm about to bless him*, no! The words that came out of the mouth of Isaac had the ability to change Jacob's destiny and bring promotion that otherwise would not have been.

Let me show you something else. The Aaronic blessing is one of the most well-known. God gave it to Moses as an instruction for how the Aaronic priesthood was to bless the people. It's found in Numbers 6:22-26 which says:

Numbers 6:22-26

22 The Lord said to Moses, 23 “Tell Aaron and his sons, ‘This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them: 24 “The Lord bless you and keep you; 25 the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; 26

the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.”

Notice how the Lord says the blessing must be given: “ **This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them ...**” The priests had to speak words. Words are more than just sounds coming out of your mouth. Words are spiritual resources that create environments. You can't see an argument. But you can walk into a room where an argument just took place and feel the tension in the air. Why? Because of the words that were spoken. When you tell someone, “I love you,” you are creating an environment of love. The words that you release determines the environment that you create.

Words on Water

When I say that words can change the environment, this is something that can actually be proven scientifically. In the early 1990s, researcher and pseudoscientist, Masuro Emoto began conducting a series of experiments with water. He had someone speak different words over containers of distilled water to see what effect, if any, the words would have on the water. What he discovered was astounding!

Before speaking the words, a sample of the water was frozen and examined under a special microscope. Then words were spoken over the same water, and a sample was again immediately frozen and examined under the microscope. Emoto found that the word spoken changed the formation of the water crystal in a way that reflected the word that was spoken.

For example, if the words “thank you” were spoken, the resulting frozen water crystal would create a beautiful shape. If, on the other hand, the words “you make me sick” were spoken, the resulting water crystal would look diseased and deformed reflecting those words. The conclusive results of the research indicated that words change the molecular structure of water.

My God! Are you hearing this? And while you're thinking about that, consider the fact that you are about 70 per cent water. That means that the words you speak are first of all affecting you. Now think of the food you eat. Whether you realize it or not, all of it contains water. Imagine speaking negative words while you're eating and then putting that food with its altered molecular composition into your body. Is it any wonder the Bible tells us that

we should speak a certain kind of words over the food we eat?

Paul warned Timothy that in the latter days, people will be seduced into believing false doctrines, such as commanding people not to eat certain things. But look at what he gives us as the remedy:

1 Timothy 4:1-5

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; 2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; 3 Forbidding to marry, and *commanding to abstain from meats*, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth. 4 *For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving: 5 For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer [emphasis added].*

Paul is telling us that when we give thanks and speak the Word of God and pray over our food, we sanctify it. We are releasing proper words that change the molecular structure of the food creating an environment of health from which our bodies can benefit. If there's death in the food in any form, we can speak words that give life, sanctifying it with the Word of God.

I know some of you are ready to run with that one and start binding the fat calories in that tub of ice cream you want to devour. But it doesn't work quite like that. You cannot ignore one biblical principle while embracing another. The fruit of the spirit is still self-control, and just because you can do something doesn't mean you should. So, go and put the tub back in the freezer and grab an apple instead.

Emoto's experiments did not end with spoken words only. They were expanded to include thoughts and words written on labels on the outside of the containers of water. The results were the same. If someone stood near the water and focused their thoughts on a particular word, the crystal would reflect the thoughts. For example, the word 'elephant' was written on a label and placed on a container of water. When they examined the water crystal from that container, they saw that it took the shape of an elephant.

These findings should not come as such a surprise to you because the Bible

already told you that a man's thoughts affect him. Thoughts are simply words that have not been verbalized. That is why we are admonished to be aware of our thoughts. We must get rid of any thought that is contrary to the truth of who God says you are and what He says you have.

2 Corinthians 10:5

Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.

You need to understand that the devil has no power over you except that which you give to him. The only way you can relinquish that power is with your own words. That is why it is vital to govern your thoughts with the Word of God. Thoughts become words spoken, and words spoken will affect change. They emit energy that continues to work long after the words have been spoken. Scientists have been able to verify that through experimentation.

Phantom DNA

In the early 1990s, Russian physicist, Vladimir Poponin, went to the United States to finish a series of experiments. He wanted to investigate the relationship between human DNA and the stuff our world is made out of, little packets of energy or particles of light we call photons. He took a glass tube and extracted all the air out of it, creating a vacuum. Except for these little particles of light (photons), the tube was completely empty. Poponin measured the particles of light to see how they were distributed. As expected, the particles were distributed randomly in the tube. Now, here is where it gets interesting.

He placed some human DNA into the tube then remeasured the photons. To his surprise, the presence of the human DNA caused the photons to come into alignment. What was chaotic before was now brought into order. The DNA was having a direct effect on the stuff from which our world is made.

In the next phase of the experiment, Poponin and his team removed the DNA sample from the tube. But instead of the photons returning to their disordered state, they remained ordered as if the DNA was still there. The pattern came

from the energy field that remained after the sample was removed. That is referred to as phantom DNA because the effect lasts whether the DNA is there or not.

The Phantom DNA Effect proves that something within us has an effect on the world around us. Have you ever noticed that while a house is occupied, barring gross neglect or natural catastrophe, the roof will not cave? The grass or weeds may get overgrown, and there will be typical maintenance issues but only to a certain extent. But if that same house has no human inhabitant, it will deteriorate much faster. The grass and weeds will quickly get overgrown, rodents will take over, and everything about that house will become rundown. The presence of a human being brings a certain order.

There is no word more powerful than the Word of God. If a human being with normal DNA can have such an effect on his or her surroundings, what more you? You carry God! And as you feed your spirit with the Word of God, you become a walking warehouse of God energized words, and your DNA is supercharged with the life and light of God. Your very presence brings order, and when you speak, things change.

Hyper-Communication

In an earlier chapter, we saw that DNA is a language with syntax and semantics. You can communicate with it. What's more, you have the DNA of God in you, which gives you the supernatural ability to speak like He does, on His frequency, affecting everything around you. The DNA Phantom effect proves that right now, your DNA is communicating with the stuff that makes up our world. Your DNA is talking even when you're not talking. Scientists call this hypercommunication. And when hyper-communication occurs, observable phenomena takes place in the actual DNA.

Hyper-communication is at work in nature all the time. The organized flow of insect life proves this. An example of this is when a queen ant is separated physically from her colony. Even if she is far away, the ant colony will continue to build according to the plans she transmits to the consciousness of the colony. However, if the distant queen dies, all work in the colony stops. The other ants no longer know what to do. As long as she is alive, the queen can be as far away as she wants and still have a consciousness of the group.

Hyper-communication is not a phenomenon unique to ants or the insect kingdom. Human beings also experience hypercommunication even if they are not aware of it in those terms. In humans, hyper-communication often is experienced when you gain access to information that is outside your knowledge base. We use much more subtle language such as “intuition,” or “inspiration,” but the concept is the same. For example, have you ever suddenly thought of a friend or relative and almost instantaneously, the phone rings, and it is that person on the other end? That is what scientists refer to as hyper-communication. Another example is when a mother experiences something happening to her child even when they are great distances from each other.

Since communication with DNA is possible only when you’re on the same frequency, that means the DNA of God in me can communicate with the DNA of God in you. We don’t have to be in the same location for change to take place. You can tune in to our Good News TV network on Sky 596, or you can watch me minister on livestream or any of our other social media outlets and connect with the words I am speaking. As a prophet, I can be in the UK and declare a *tslach*(sent) word that can locate you in Timbuktu, New York, Djibouti, or wherever you are and reprogram you for prosperity. The spiritual overrides the physical, the DNA of God in me connects with the DNA of God in you, and distance is no longer a barrier.

How is this explained scientifically? The Russian scientists discovered that our DNA could cause disturbing patterns in the vacuum of space, thus producing magnetized wormholes. Wormholes are tunnel connections between entirely different areas in the universe through which information can be transmitted outside of space and time. Things can travel through a hole in one part of space and come out through a hole in another part of space. Your DNA attracts these bits of information and passes them on to your consciousness. To many, that is a theory as idealistic as Star Trek’s transporter “Beam me up, Scotty!” time travel. But it’s not as far-fetched as you might think.

There is a reported incident of a male nurse who dreamt he was hooked up to a kind of knowledge CD-ROM. In the dream, verifiable information from all imaginable fields was transmitted to him. When he woke up the next morning, he was able to recall all the information he received in the dream. It

was as though an entire encyclopaedia was downloaded to his personal knowledge base. He was flooded with information and technical details, much of which he knew absolutely nothing about just the night before. That is an example of hyper-communication, gaining access to information that is outside your knowledge base.

DNA has the capacity to cause cosmic changes. Scientists see this as a credible reality (though they may not be able to prove their theory yet physically). But in the science of Christianity, we have proved this time and time again in the realm of the supernatural.

You are divinely designed to speak words of power, to affect environments and cause changes of cosmic proportions. But there is a consciousness you must have so that this will work for you. Once you get what I'm about to show you in these next few pages, you will be an unstoppable force. You will become a barrier breaker and a line crosser, a bona fide proof-producing Christian.

Chapter Five

Words and the Mind

Life itself is a series of decisions, choices you make based on your thoughts. Whatever you say and do is first a thought inside your head. Your mind, not your spirit, is the trigger for unlimited capacity and potential in your life. It all starts in the mind with the thoughts you are thinking.

God gives us this incredible gift of being able to think and choose. And whether you realise it or not, every decision you make is a choice for life or death. That is a scientific fact and a spiritual reality. Your thoughts change everything about you, and I don't mean that in a theoretical sense. I mean every time you have a thought, you are literally changing right then and there.

The thoughts you are thinking right now are impacting every single cell in your body. Not only that, but the thoughts you are thinking now are also impacting those you have a relationship with even though you can't see it happening. I know that's a lot to take in, so let me repeat. Your thoughts right

now are impacting your cells—all thirty to forty trillion of them. And because of how your life intertwines with those with whom you have a relationship, your thoughts are also affecting them.

If you thought that was shocking, hold on to your hat because I'm about to shock you even more. Not only are your thoughts affecting those with whom you currently have a relationship, they are also affecting future generations. I will explain how this happens.

Thoughts Are Things

We have to start at the beginning and understand that a thought is a real thing. Now when I say a thought is a 'thing,' I'm not referring to something ethereal that's floating out there in the spiritual realm. Thoughts are physical things.

You generate thoughts from the information you receive, and much of that information comes through your physical senses. Your five senses—sight, hearing, smell, taste, and touch—are the contacts between the external world and your internal mind. You receive each event and circumstance of life through these five senses as an electromagnetic signal in your brain. As the signal moves through the brain, it impacts the DNA deep down inside the cells of the body. Then it waits there dormant. It can't do anything until you think.

Now, the brain itself is a hugely complex organ. It is so complex, only two to eight per cent of the brain is understood in the scientific world. The brain functions as a receiver; it is designed to hold the thoughts of the mind. Your brain does not control your mind. It is your mind, more specifically, your thoughts that control your brain.

Generational Thoughts

There is a branch of science called neuroscience that deals with the function and structure of the brain. Expert neuroscientists have discovered that thoughts are memories. You start building thoughts (memories) from the moment you are conceived, and every day, each time you think, you're changing those memories. The same was true for your mother and father, and each of their progenitors. Now, I want you to follow me carefully on this next

point because what I'm about to tell you will radically change the way you think.

Every cell in your body is affected by every thought you think. Those thoughts are captured as physical things and passed through the generations. That means thoughts from a father and mother come through the sperm and ova and affect the generations that follow. What comes through the previous generation is wrapped up in protein, zipped up, so to speak, and remains dormant. It won't do anything until the person carrying that DNA has a thought that comes into agreement with what is wrapped up in there. The choice of that particular thought activates what is in the DNA that was passed down.

That helps us to better understand the relevance of what God told us in Deuteronomy 30:19. That is, the choices we make lead to consequences. Let's look at it.

Deuteronomy 30:19

I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore *choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live* [emphasis added].

Thoughts lead to choices. The right thoughts will lead to the right choices, which result in life. Conversely, the wrong thoughts lead to the wrong choices, which result in death (incipient or actual). And it is clear from the latter part of that verse that the choices made not only affect the person making the choice, but also the generations following (their "seed"). Your choices have generational implications. That is why it is paramount that your mind functions the right way.

A Sound Mind

When God created you, He designed you to function as He does. As such, He wired your mind to work a certain way. Fear is alien to the way God thinks. In the same way, your mind is not designed to function out of fear.

2 Timothy 1:7

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love,

and of a sound mind.

Fear-based and otherwise negative thoughts are alien to your mind. Those negative thoughts disrupt all the natural blood flow, glucose metabolism, and electromagnetic balance. The Word of God, however, is the perfect diet for your spirit. Just as the Word of God properly feeds your spirit, you must also feast your mind on the right thoughts for it to function the way God intended. Look at what it says in Philippians 4 verse 6:

Philippians 4:6

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

The word for ‘careful’ there is the Greek word *merimnáo* which means *take thought*. It is the same word Jesus used when He said:

Matthew 6:25

Therefore I say unto you, *Take no thought* [*merimnáo*, emphasis added] for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on.

Take no thought does not mean don’t think. It means don’t take any thought that draws you away from the right way of thinking. God, the manufacturer of your mind, is telling you how to keep your mind functioning in the way He designed it to function. He is giving you instructions that will keep your DNA intact by producing the right kind of genetic memories. He doesn’t want you to worry because worry is a function of fear, and fear is an abuse—an abnormal use—of your mind. A fearful thought is a signal of the mind that unzips and expresses the thing that is dormant in your DNA and in agreement with that thought. Let me show you how it works.

Let’s say there is a son who comes from a family where the men have a history of dying of heart disease around the age of 65. The great grandfather passed that through the DNA to the grandfather; then the grandfather passed it to the father. It’s in the DNA. The son grew up hearing how his father, his father’s father, and his great grandfather all died of heart disease around the age of 65. Using that information, the son chooses the fearful thought, *I will also die of heart disease around age 65*. Then at age 65, he goes to the doctor

and is told that he has heart disease.

Why did that happen? The son's fearful thought triggered a signal from his mind to go and unlock the "memory" of heart disease lying dormant in his DNA and activated it. It didn't have to be that way for the son in our scenario. And the good news is, it doesn't have to be that way for you either. If you don't choose that fearful thought, that DNA programmed for destruction will not get unwrapped, and that negative thing that's locked in the DNA will not manifest. *Don't take that negative thought.* And I'll show you an even better way.

Reprogramming Yourself

Many Christians today are what I call miracle thieves. They come to church looking for a miracle, but miracles were never meant for the Christian. There is a life that God gave you and wants you to live that is superior to those who need miracles. A life of divine health and prosperity is for you. Christians are running here, there, and everywhere looking for deliverance. But catch what I'm about to tell you, and you will lay your hand on your own head and deliver yourself.

Your natural family may have genetically predisposed you to certain problems in your life, generational cycles of poverty, sickness, and failure. But you have a new family now. You are born again, not of corruptible seed but of the Word of God which lives and abides forever. You now have God's DNA. That means you are not a victim of your biology. When you take hold of the truth and speak the Word of God concerning your issues, you'll break that generational cycle. The Word in you will change the outcome. And when you change the outcome, you'll change your income. (You'll get that later.) When you believe and speak the Word of God, your spiritual DNA will change or override your physical DNA.

It is your choice that makes the difference. You can choose to receive the facts about your unfavourable situation, or you can choose to get the truth about your situation from the Word of God. When you get a negative report about your health, you can choose to let fear take over your thoughts and activate what's in your DNA, or you can take God's thought on the matter. How do you do that? 2 Corinthians 5:17 and Galatians 2:20 are God's

thought about any sickness you have.

2Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Galatians 2:20

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Now you know what thought to take. So, what do you do with it? You make it yours. You say:

I'm a new creation in Christ Jesus. I'm not the old me; I'm a brand new species of being. I'm not a victim of my biology because I am born from above. My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. Christ lives in me, and I refuse to allow pain and sickness in this body. Christ is my life! Hallelujah!

When you talk like that, you'll find you don't need a miracle or deliverance. All you need is the Word of God working in you. Cheer up! The Word works!

When you experience disagreeable circumstances, instead of feeding your mind with fearful, negative thoughts or, worse yet, verbalising them, ask yourself *what is the truth about that?* Then go for the Word because that is where you will find the truth about your situation. You have to choose what you believe. And it is your choice that will send the signal to your mind to unlock what's there, life or death. That's the power God gave us. We can express that word that will unlock death, or we can destroy it with the Word of God which is full of life.

Words destroy other words, even if those words are thoughts wrapped in protein inside your DNA. When you receive the truth from the Word of God, it destroys those destructive thoughts in your cells that were passed down in your biological DNA. The Word of God destroys those cells literally and physically.

Instead of thinking fear-based anxious thoughts, think about what the Word tells you to think about.

Philippians 4:8 AMPC

For the rest, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely and lovable, whatever is kind and winsome and gracious, if there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think on and weigh and take account of these things [fix your minds on them].

Thoughts come to you all the time. Your mind, the conscious and the subconscious, is working right now. Myriads of signals are coming through your mind *right now*. Then you take the one you choose. You have the power to choose to think about those kinds of things mentioned in Philippians 4:8. And when you choose, you control what your DNA does. Even if you don't feel like doing it, you can still choose the thought to take. Refuse to be led by your feelings. Instead, be led by the Spirit of God, and He leads you by the Word of God.

Your Powerful Mind

As I said before, the brain does not control the mind; it is the mind that controls the brain. That means you're not a victim of your biology, and by biology, I mean your DNA from the sub-atomic particles on a quantum level up to the macro level of your actual body. Your thought life controls your brain, and then the brain, through chemicals, controls the physical body. Everything about you is controlled by the way your mind is functioning. Right now, as you're reading these words, you're thinking which is causing multiple genes across your entire body to respond to what you're reading. Your genes are expressing. That is to say, in your brain, the genes are making proteins carrying instructions. So right this instant, at 400-billion actions per second, you're building physical thoughts about this information you're reading. The signal comes in, your mind activates that signal, then things from your subconscious mind move to your conscious mind to help you understand this incoming information. All of this is happening faster than the speed of light.

The choice you make as you read this is the signal that unzips particular

DNA. The gene then expresses, the protein forms, and the memory starts building tree-like structures in the brain to hold that information. As you're thinking and learning new information, branches form on the tree. You can grow unlimited branches—one branch per concept—and they're all connected. Secular neuroscientists estimate that you've got over three million years of space in your brain. That is an *estimation* of the capacity of the brain God gave you. Yes, your brain, right there! That may be difficult for you to conceive. But remember, you're created in the image of a brilliant God who has unlimited capacity.

The more you think, the more branches you grow and the more intelligent you become. That is called neuroplasticity. And every time you think, you are redesigning the landscape of your brain. Which means you're not the same now as you were before reading what you just read.

Your Good Mind

When God made you, He did not put any negative pathways in your brain. You had to wire them in. You learned to do that. Every time you don't listen to God and make a wrong choice, those proteins in your DNA build the wrong things. That is what the enemy wants to happen which is why he attacks your mind. He wants you to choose the wrong thoughts. But even your body understands that is not the way it's supposed to be.

Your immune system recognises a negative thought or wrong choice in the same way it recognises a virus or a physical wound. Your body sees it as a viral invasion, so it builds inflammation in that area of the brain. That means, when you're thinking a negative or toxic thought, that area of your brain becomes damaged and remains that way unless you deal with that thought and get rid of it.

The good news is, that is not your destiny. You can “make the tree good” by renewing your mind with the Word of God.

Romans 12:2

And be not conformed to this world: but *be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind* [emphasis added], that ye may prove what is that

good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

I don't want you to miss what this scripture is saying. It says, be ye *transformed*. The Greek word translated as transformed in that passage is *metamorphóō*. It actually means to be transfigured in physical form the same way a caterpillar is metamorphosed into a butterfly. This is the kind of transformation that takes place when you renew your mind! Hallelujah!

As you renew your mind with the Word of God which communicates the thoughts of God, you're resetting to factory default. You're putting your mind back to its original state so that it functions the way God initially intended: no negative pathways. You're designed to be addicted to God, and to be addicted to God is to be addicted to good. Addiction as a negative thing is a perversion of God's original intent. You are designed to be continually communicating with, absorbed, stimulated, and led by the Spirit of God. You're addicted to the good. That is what your mind craves. Everything that we need for our lives, God has already done it. It's up to us to align ourselves with His Word to hear what we're supposed to be doing to activate what He's already done.

Your Conscious Mind

You're designed to think only good thoughts. Therefore, there is a consciousness you must have to ensure only good things are happening in your thought life. The Bible says it this way:

2 Corinthians 10:5

Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and *bringing into captivity every thought* [emphasis added] to the obedience of Christ

God says, bring *all* thoughts into captivity, not some thoughts on Monday and a few more on Wednesday. He said all thoughts, all day long, every day. Refuse to accept any thought that draws you away from your sound mind, the place of peace which God intends for you to have in your thought life. Reject fear, because if you have a mind full of fear, it's not sound and it will cause real brain damage.

Those thoughts carrying death may have come through your generations, but you are not bound by them. You can renew your mind. They remain dormant unless you activate them or destroy them. When you do what the Bible says and consciously think on good things, you're in the zone for which you were designed. And when you start learning to think God's thoughts by thinking God's Word, you'll start living His supernatural life.

Thoughts become words, and if we are aligning our thoughts with the Word of God, we'll speak the right words. As we delve into this next chapter, I will show you exactly how to do that.

Chapter Six

Reprogramming your Words

Never think that when words are communicated nothing is happening. I assure you, something is happening every time. That is why when words are spoken against you, you must use words to respond. We see this in Isaiah 54:17:

Isaiah 54:17

No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn [emphasis added]. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.

Remember the secret I shared with you: words cancel other words. The verse says, “every *tongue*.” That’s talking about words. The power of the tongue is words. Notice the Bible says “every tongue (word) that shall *rise against thee*...” That tells you why you must respond to that word. That word spoken is not just sitting there. It is rising or rearing up against you.

The word for ‘rise’ in that verse is the Hebrew word *quwm* (pronounced *koom*), and one of the meanings of that word is to *succeed*. Brother, sister, if you don’t want that word spoken against you to succeed, you’ve got to open up your mouth and condemn it. *Rash* that word! That’s the Hebrew word for condemn, and it means *to declare wrong, disturb, make trouble*. Your words

can disturb the words spoken against you. Use your words to trouble the words that came to trouble you. I make it a daily practice to rise up and condemn with my mouth any words spoken against me or anything connected to me. You ought to do the same. Condemn evil words, negative words that rise up against you in judgment, even if those words came from your own mouth.

Working the Word

Be a person of the Word. The Word has a certain way of working, and it works when you work it. You may be wondering why the Word is not working in your life. Here is the trick for the Word to work, and if you listen to what I'm about to tell you, your whole world will change.

The Word you are holding every day in your Bible is the *logos*. But when that Word comes out of your mouth, it becomes *rhema*: a specific word given to a specific person in a specific situation at a specific time. You have to know how to pick your *rhema* from the *logos*. Let me show you how it's done. Proverbs chapter 4, verse 20 says:

Proverbs 4:20

My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

The word 'attend' there is the Hebrew word *qashab*. It means *to prick up the ears*. Have you ever seen a dog's ears perk up when it hears something? It's positioning its ears to hear. When you *qashab*, you position your ears to hear what I'm about to say, to my words (*dabar*), which means my *utterances*.

Understand what the Word is saying. As the Word comes to you, be ready to hear everything it's saying. But this next part is the revelation that causes a lot of people to miss their miracle. The verse says, "incline your ears to my sayings." The word for 'sayings' is the Hebrew word *émer* which means *promises*. Now, don't miss this. It says *incline* your ears. The Hebrew word translated as incline there is *natah*, and it literally means to bend, pervert, or to turn aside.

No matter the evidence of your downfall, your heart and mind ought to be biased to what you know God has said about your life. It is a conscious

decision to be one-sided. This is why the prophet Isaiah said, “who hath believed our report?” You make a decision and pitch your mind on what God says. No matter what life throws at you, you remain immovable.

Wisdom teacher Dr Mike Murdock said, whenever you want to believe the Bible, why believe the burning part? He meant that many Christians are more inclined to believe the parts of the Bible that speak about hellfire and destruction. There are some Christians who believe in Hell more than they believe in prosperity. Why not incline your ears to the prosperity part? Whenever you hear or read the promises of God, go in that direction. The Bible says *natah* those scriptures, detect what is for you. Detect it. When the Word is ministered to you or when you read it, have your ears open for everything the Word has to say, but detect what is yours. Locate *your* Word. Put blinders on where everything else is concerned and bend towards the promises. Incline your ear to your prosperity! Incline your ear to your health! *Natah!*

Now, there is another part to this that you need to understand. First, you attend (*qashab*)—prick your ears—to the Word of God. As you do that, you incline (*natah*) your ear to the promises of God listening for what is specifically for you. Then you have to *keep* that Word. Watch what it says:

Proverbs 4:21

Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.

The word ‘keep’ is the word *shamar*, which means *to keep near, guard, protect, garrison*, to become a watchman and have charge over. You are responsible for the results that the word of God is yielding in your life. You have to take charge and watch over the Word you have received.

You will find there are certain scriptures that you are more drawn to. Keep or put an army around those scriptures in your heart. Those are your set apart scriptures. God put them in there specifically for you.

Verse 23 also tells you to ‘keep,’ but this is not the word *shamar*.

Proverbs 4:23

Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

That word ‘keep’ is *natsar*, which also means *to guard* but in the sense of keeping *watch over* a thing. If you want the Word to start working in your life, keep your heart with all diligence. Watch over your heart so as to guard it from danger. Don’t just allow anything in your spirit. The Word that you receive is something that you ought to consciously protect and keep in your heart if it is to yield results.

Of everything that comes your way, you can choose what influences the course of your life by deliberately focusing on what the word of God has to say about your life. Even some scriptures should never be in your heart. Some scriptures just don’t apply to you. Watch over your heart and guard against what enters. Jesus said, behold I stand at the door and knock. If even Jesus has to knock to get into your heart, why then would you allow stupid people to get into your heart? Why would you open the door for the enemy? Guard your heart.

Be among people who talk positive. I will never talk poverty, sickness, or fear. Never! Let me show you why you shouldn't either. Apostle Paul in the book of Romans says this:

Romans 8:28

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Synergéō is the Greek word that’s used there for ‘work together.’ That’s where we get the word synergy. Synergy is the interaction or cooperation of two or more organizations, substances, or other agents to produce a combined effect greater than the sum of their separate effects. We know, we have an awareness, that all things work together (*synergéō*). That means you can never be disadvantaged. If someone asks how you’re doing, you should never be the one to say, *I’m well, under the circumstances*. What would you be doing under the circumstances? No circumstance will be over you. Say, *all things work together for my good. I can never be disadvantaged! No circumstance will be over me!* Say that for yourself!

Your Kingdom Identity

God never expected you to use the Word to change your situation. I know that comes as a surprise to you, but that was not God's purpose for giving you the Word. I know right there you are wondering, *what then is the purpose of the Word?* I'm glad you asked. When you read the Word, you discover the person of Jesus because Jesus is the Word. In the process of discovering Jesus through His Word, you discover who you are. And when you discover who you are—your potential and your abilities—you change the world.

When you discover your identity, when you speak, you speak from a place of power. You'll say, *I can turn this situation around. I will not allow this disease to be in my body. I'll never be broke another day of my life. It's impossible for me to be broke. It's impossible for me to be sick. I refuse to be sick!*

So, the Word is meant for you to discover Jesus. There's a revelation in this. Look at what John 5:39 says:

John 5:39

Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me.

Here's the revelation : *the scriptures don't have life.* I'll wait while you take a few moments to let that sink in. Jesus said, **“in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me.”**

You think that in the scriptures you'll find life. But that's not what God is saying. It's you who thinks that way. When you search the scriptures because you think inside the scriptures is life, you are lying to yourself. Jesus is saying, the scriptures point to Me, the real Life. Let me explain it another way.

Imagine standing in Trafford Centre, one of the largest shopping centres in Manchester in the UK, and you see a sign that says 250 miles to London. Then you receive a call. The person on the other end asks you where you are, and you look at the sign and say, I'm in London. Do you see how nonsensical that is? Are you in London? No, you're not! You're looking at a sign which directs you to London. Looking at the sign does not mean you've arrived at the real thing. The sign only points you to the real thing. There should always

be the understanding that the Bible is simply a signpost to the Person of Jesus Christ.

It is Christ who gives you your identity. He tells you who you are and what belongs to you. So, if you have a health problem, get in the Word and find out what Christ has done to secure your health. Don't talk sickness. Talk about the health that He says is yours. Boldly declare, *by His stripes I was healed!* When your money is looking funny, and your change is looking strange, don't talk about how broke you are. Look into the Word and declare, *He became poor so that I might be rich. Therefore, I am rich!* When you read about the success of entrepreneurs in the marketplace, don't think *I could never do that.* No! Boldly declare *I can do all things through Christ. I'm sufficient in His sufficiency. I've got what it takes to succeed. I'm more than a conqueror! I'm taking over!*

Everything on Earth is waiting for you to realize who you are and open your mouth and declare words. The Bible says it this way:

Romans 8:19

For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

Be conscious of the reality that you are the living breathing headquarters of God. You are a God carrier. The laws that govern you are different to the laws that govern the world. Christ has made you a king, and a king releases power through his word.

Revelation 1:6

And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Ecclesiastes 8:4a

Where the word of a king is, there is power

Whenever you see a kingdom, you see power at work through the commands of the king. You are a king. Open your mouth and release words. The moment words come out of your mouth, there is power. As a king, learn how to release words. The Bible says to preach the Gospel to every creature, not every person, and the Gospel is good news. Preach good news to your bank account. Preach to your business. Words should be released over your career,

ministry, body, health, money, every area of your life. Your words are your first employees. Make them work for you. Any words not working for your advancement in life should be sacked!

“Receiving” and Returning

Anything is possible, and that’s not a religious cliché. It’s real! If you believe God’s Word, it will produce results for you. People think if a word is from God, it should just work. But that’s not what the Bible says. Let me explain further using a relatively well-known passage from the book of Isaiah:

Isaiah 55:8

For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, saith the Lord.

If you stop right there, you will not get the right revelation. You have to understand the pretext of the context of the text before you can understand the text. What you just read is the pretext of the context, not the text. So, let’s read further so you can get the context before we understand the text.

Isaiah 55:9

For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.

Now, the word ‘for’ there is the Hebrew word *kî*, which can be interpreted as “but.” So, you can read that verse like this:

Isaiah 55:9

***But* [emphasis added] as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.**

‘But’ (in verse 9) is used to contrast what has already been mentioned; therefore, it cancels the previous verse. Verses 8 and 9 are the pretext and the context respectively. Let’s read on to see what God is really saying in the text.

Isaiah 55:10-11

10 For [*but*] as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and

returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: 11 So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

Here again, the ‘but’ (verse 10) cancels out the previous verse. That means He is not talking about His thoughts and ways being higher than yours. He’s drawing your attention to something else. God is telling you *how* His Word comes down from His level to your level. He says His thoughts come down like rain or snow. In other words, they come from that high level where He is down to the earth where you are.

God’s thoughts come through His Word to you. It’s like tennis where one player (God) serves the ball, and the other player (you) returns it. It only works when the ball is returned.

Isaiah 58:11

So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: *it shall not return unto Me void* [emphasis added], but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

So, God serves the Word to you: “you are prosperous.” But that Word doesn’t do anything until you agree with what He is saying. It’s like the thought (we read about in the previous chapter) that is the signal that triggers what’s dormant in the DNA. Nothing happens until you agree. So, when God says, “you are prosperous,” you return by saying, “I am prosperous!”

The Word only works on the return journey . When your mouth begins to utter what God says about you, that’s when you start to change your situation. That’s one of the biggest problems a lot of Christians have when the Word of God comes to them. They don’t return it; they only say, “I receive.” That’s like swinging your racket and completely missing when the ball is served to you. In tennis, that’s called a fault. It doesn’t return anything. If I’m ministering the Word to you, and I declare “You are rich!” say, “I am rich!” Say exactly what God says, then you know the Word that was served to you is on a return journey. Speak what God says to you.

Believing and Speaking

The Word is so powerful it has the ability to produce in in your life and in you what it says. It can get down into the marrow of your bones (see Hebrews 4:12), that's the manufacturing plant of your blood. The Word is higher than the blood. It can produce new blood. If you have HIV, diabetes, or any disease affecting your blood, the Word can go to the bone marrow and create new blood cells.

In many of our services and crusades, we have people with diabetes who are sent to the back to get tested right there in the service. After they've been tested, I tell them to walk past my shadow, and diabetes will be removed. They walk past my shadow, then we send them to the back of the room where the doctors and nurses are waiting. When they get tested again, their blood is no longer diabetic. What changed? People think it's the shadow that does this. It's not the shadow, it's the Word working with the faith of the person. Paul said it this way:

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

The power of God to produce salvation is to everyone who believes. If you don't believe, it will not work. You must believe the Word of God in your heart and then act upon it using your mouth.

Romans 10:8-10

8 But what saith it? *The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith [emphasis added], which we preach; 9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

You receive the word of salvation when you believe with your heart, not your mind or your brain. But that's only the first part of receiving. When you believe it, *you've got to say it*. If you believe it and don't say it, it will not

work. Your heart must line up with the Word of God, then with your mouth, you make the proclamation. That's the principle of the Kingdom of God, and that principle governs everything about your life and relationship with God. Believe with your heart, then say it with your mouth.

Many people don't understand this principle, so they have the Word in their mouths but not in their hearts. If it's not in your mouth *and* in your heart, it will not work. If it's in your heart but not in your mouth, it will not work. It's got to be both in your heart and in your mouth.

The biggest problem of many Christians around the world is that they are ignorant of the Word of God. Jesus said:

Matthew 22:29

Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

The Body of Christ today abounds with error. That's why the accurate teaching of the Word of God is so crucial. If Christians are going to live a victorious life, they've got to understand the scriptures.

The Bible is the Word of God, and the Word of God is the wisdom of God. If you don't have the Word, you don't have the wisdom of God. The wisdom of man may take you some distance, but only the wisdom of God will take you all the way.

Paul refers to the "word of faith" that is in your mouth (Romans 10:8). Faith is a law which says, if your mouth speaks with your heart believing, there will be a result, a manifestation. When you understand spiritual laws and act on them, they will produce results. Your heart and your mouth must work together. If you just say the words but in you're thinking something contrary to what you're saying, those words will not work for you. They are not faith-filled, so there's no power to back it up.

Put Your Words to Work

Everything you need is wrapped up in the Word. The Word rescues your mind from negative pathways enabling you to produce the right words. James

says the implanted Word will save your soul.

James 1:21

Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls [emphasis added].

What is going to happen in your life is based on what you're thinking in your subconscious mind. What you plant in your mind will determine what you think. What you think gets into your heart, and that's what you begin to say and what comes to pass.

Once you declare right words (based on the Word of God), hold fast to that confession. We saw in a previous chapter how you can use the thoughts of God, which are His words, to cancel negative thoughts or words. Remember, words cancel other words. That means the converse is also true. You can use negative thoughts or words to cancel the good words you declared.

So, be mindful of your words. Speak with intentionality; have a consciousness of what you're saying. Refuse to attack or undermine in your conversations what you declared in your proclamations. Your words carry power. Your words are your employees. Make them work for you. The moment you declare, "I am a multi-millionaire!" you have employed those words to go out and work for you. You may not know how, but that word is working.

The good you enjoy in life is a direct result of the fruit of your words. That's what the Bible tells us in the book of Proverbs:

Proverbs 12:14

A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth.

Use your words as seeds. You don't plant a tree today and look for fruit tomorrow. It takes time. So, keep saying the same words. Something is happening. Keep saying it; don't stop talking it. Keep saying it, and you will see in your life what the Bible declares in the book of Acts:

Acts 19:20

So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.

Hallelujah! The Word of God that you keep saying will prevail over every negative symptom, circumstance, and situation in your life. That word you speak goes out of your mouth and creates an environment in your future waiting for you to come and enjoy it. Say it before you can have it. If you don't say it, you'll never have it. It's a principle. Maintain that confession, and it will happen.

You have seen in this chapter how your faith-filled words work to produce the results you want. Now, as we get into this next chapter, you are about to discover the power that is locked in the word of agreement. Let's dig deeper.

Chapter Seven

Unified Words

By now, you are starting to realise the power of your words as an individual. Imagine how much more powerful it would be if we collectively used our words to effect change. When we come together, speaking the same language, the impossible becomes possible.

That is what happened with the building of the Tower of Babel. The people came together and decided to complete a building project, but not just any building project. They decided to build a tower that reached Heaven. Their accomplishment was so amazing, God Himself came down to take a look at the work in progress.

Genesis 11:2-5

2 And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there. 3 And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar. 4 And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. 5 And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower,

which the children of men builded.

How was it possible that mere men could cast such a remarkable vision and set out to accomplish a feat so great? It started with words. They were unified in their language. That is what the Bible tells us in Genesis chapter 11:

Genesis 11:1, 6

1 And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. 6 And the Lord said, Behold, the people is one, and *they have all one language and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do* [emphasis added].

The word for ‘speech’ there is the Hebrew word *saphah*. This word conveys more than just having the same dialect. It means they were also in total agreement. Some Jewish scholars believe that they spoke the Hebrew language precisely as God created it, and those words carried just the right power, energy, or vibrations. These were thought to be words that would produce supernatural results. They would have certainly achieved their goal except for one grave mistake they made. Let’s read it from the text in Genesis:

Genesis 11:7-9

7 Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. 8 So the Lord scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city. 9 Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the Lord did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the Lord scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

In their pride and lofty ambition, they had excluded God completely. Consequently, God disrupted their plans by confusing their language. God wants us to be unified, and He wants us to use our words for the advancement of His Kingdom and His purpose for our lives.

A Unified Language

Several years ago, I was featured in *Forbes* magazine and noted to have an estimated net worth of \$60 million. Let me just dispel any rumours and speculation right here for all of those who might have wondered what my real net worth is. My net worth is whatever my mouth declares it to be. And so is yours. Don't allow any organisation, the economy or the balance in your bank account dictate what your worth is. Your faith filled words determine how much of your potentiality you will realise.

If this is true of each of us as individuals (and it is), how much more so if we make a conscious group effort to say what God says about who we are, what we have, and what we can do? When we as a unified people speak the same thing, boldly declaring the Word of God, nothing shall be impossible to us. That is the empowerment the Holy Ghost came to give us.

When the Holy Ghost came to the disciples waiting in the Upper Room on the day of Pentecost, the first thing He did was give them all a glorious unified language.

Acts 2:1, 4

1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

It was the reverse of what happened at Babel. They were now empowered by this language of God to do the impossible once again.

If we are going to do great things for God, cast incredible vision, and realise the impossible, there is a certain language we must employ. These are words that are reserved for a select few, an esoteric language that we as Christians are privileged to use. With these God-energised words in our mouths, they will say of us what God said of the people at Babel: nothing will be restrained from them which they have imagined to do!

The Potential of Group Consciousness

As usual, scientists are just catching on to what the Bible has already said. They use different terminology but refer to the same thing. They call this ability of a group to use a unified language or communication to effect

changes Group Collective Consciousness.

Do you remember the queen ant, how she was able to influence the group consciousness of the colony even from a distance? In their book *Vernetzte Intelligenz*(Networked

Intelligence)¹, authors Grazyna Gosar and Franz Bludorf

provide an in-depth explanation of this idea of group consciousness. They quote sources that presume in earlier times humanity functioned much like the queen ant and the colony. That is to say, humans were powerfully connected to the group consciousness and therefore, acted as a group. But according to those sources, human beings had to suppress this group consciousness almost entirely so that they could develop and experience individuality.

Their premise is that since we are now relatively stable in our individual consciousness, we can create a new form of group consciousness. This new group consciousness would allow each of us to freely gain access to all information via our DNA without the influence of a “queen ant” remotely controlling what each person could do with that information.

We now know that just like the internet, our DNA can feed appropriate data into its network, retrieve data from the network, and establish contact with other participants in the network. The concepts of group consciousness and hypercommunication, aka "networked intelligence," provides scientists with a fresh interpretation and explanation of phenomena such as remote healing, telepathy or "remote sensing" about the state of relatives etc.

Distinctive individuality is key to any collective consciousness. Otherwise, according to Gosar and Bludorf, we would revert to a primitive herd instinct, easily manipulated much like the ant colony by the queen ant. Researchers believe that if humans with full individuality regained group consciousness, they would have a god-like power to create, alter and shape things on Earth. They also believe humanity as a whole is moving toward this group consciousness of the new kind.

For example, when children start school, the educational system lumps them

all together, classifies fifty per cent of them as problem children, and demands adjustment. But the individuality of today's children is so strong that many of them reject this adjustment and refuse to give up their unique traits that are particular to their individual personalities. Something in those children, some inherent desire, pushes them more and more towards this group consciousness of the new kind, and they refuse to suppress it.

Changing Our Environment

Researchers have only begun to scratch the surface of the possibilities and power of such a consciousness. What a single individual may not be able to do on his own can be accomplished by a group of individuals using the influence of group consciousness. Take the weather, for example. As a rule, the weather is rather difficult for a single individual to influence. Scientists have found that it can, however, be influenced through group consciousness. You may wonder how such a thing is possible. Let me explain it this way.

We spoke in an earlier chapter of how a person's DNA can access information that is outside of that person's knowledge base. That is known as hyper-communication. When a person experiences hyper-communication, there are electromagnetic fields that are emitted in the vicinity of that person. These fields are so powerful, they can cause interference with electronic devices like CD players, computers and the like, disrupting their function for hours. As the electromagnetic field slowly dissipates, the devices function normally again. All this while you may have thought you were technically inept, but it may be that you are just exceptionally good at hyper-communication. But what does all of that have to do with group consciousness and the weather? Read on, and you will begin to realise the potential that lies within you.

Seismologists—scientists who study the mechanical properties of the Earth—discovered that the Earth undergoes constant oscillation. Just like humans emit an electromagnetic field in hyper-communication, the Earth has an electromagnetic field which also emits sounds or frequencies. Right now as you're reading this, the Earth is humming. As the Earth emits these frequencies (also known to some as Schumann resonances), they affect the weather.

Here is where it gets even more fascinating. The sound waves or frequencies that the Earth emits are the same frequencies that are produced in our brains. So, if many people synchronise their thinking or focus their thoughts in a laser-like fashion, then scientifically speaking, they can communicate with the Earth and influence the weather. That is only one example of the power of this new kind of group consciousness.

Managing Our Resources

I want you to pause for a moment and consider the implications of what you just read. Think of the possibilities of what else we could accomplish if we came together in unity. That is precisely what researchers of group consciousness are doing.

In their exploration, they formulated the theory of Type I civilisations in which the people manage all of the planet's energy and material resources. Humanity in such a civilisation would use its ability to communicate in a unified way to develop a group consciousness of the new kind. Such a consciousness would have control of the resources of its home planet. As a natural consequence, they would eradicate scarcity of energy and environmental problems, including all natural catastrophes. Researchers did not stop there. They also theorised a Type II civilisation that would control not only the resources of its planet but also all the energies of their home galaxy.

Bringing Order to Our World

Scientists have been studying the direct effects of consciousness on the physical world for several decades. In the lab experiments, a person would sit near a device that produces random numbers but without any physical connection to it. Then the person would attempt to “communicate” with the device, willing it, so to speak, to change its behaviour and produce higher or lower scores.

The accumulated research showed a correlation indicating that the consciousness of a person can affect the physical world in a weak but measurable way. It was as if the consciousness of the individual communicated with the environment and impressed the necessary

information on it, thus creating a tiny bit of order in the world.

If individuals could singularly affect the physical elements around them, what effect could a group of individuals exerting a unified conscious effort have? That was the impetus for the next phase of the experiments. What would be the effect of a worldwide New Year's celebration or 2.5 billion people watching the funeral of Princess Diana in England, for example? That is what the scientists set out to analyse.

A sort of world wide web network of these random number generators was set up, and the experiment moved from the lab to a global environment. Here is what they found. Whenever a large number of people focus their attention (or consciousness) on the same thing (like Diana's funeral, for example), the random number generators delivered ordered numbers instead of random ones. They concluded that focused group consciousness creates order in its entire surroundings.

Dr Roger Nelson, the pioneer of this research at Princeton University, summarised the effects of the experiments so far: "There is solid empirical evidence that we do interact directly with each other and the world in the domain of consciousness, despite physical barriers and separations ... The effect of global consciousness is concentrated during those special times when humanity experiences broadly shared interests, feelings, and reactions."²

An Esoteric Language for an Esoteric People

When a great number of people come together in unity of mind, purpose and words, the potential is unlimited. This is scientifically proven, and more importantly, biblically true. Apostle Paul encouraged what scientists would call group collective consciousness. He said it this way:

1 Corinthians 1:10

Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

If we would do what Paul said—speak the same thing with no divisions among ourselves—we would demonstrate to the entire world that we are indeed partakers— participators, sharers—of the divine nature.

2 Peter 1:3-4

3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

We are not ordinary. We have the promises of God, words that we as the Body of Christ can use to function as He does. All we need is the knowledge of Christ.

The sons and daughters of God are known by their words. They talk like God talks, words full of power, light, and life. They speak, and things shift; environments change; things come into order. All of creation is waiting for you to open your mouth and speak words.

Romans 8:19

For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

We don't talk like the world does. When they say things are going down, we stand together as the Body of Christ and say, *not so!*

Job 22:29a

When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up.

When the news networks are broadcasting that coronavirus is running rampant, we say, *no weapon formed against us will prosper for the law of the Spirit of life makes us free from the law of sin and death.* When the economists say we are experiencing inflation, we can boldly say, *we are givers: sponsors of the Gospel. Therefore, we are abundantly supplied according to His riches in glory.*

We have a different kind of group consciousness. Our words come from knowledge that is superior to secular science. We are a Christ conscious

people who speak the esoteric language of God.

Throughout this book we have examined the genetics of words and how words can be used to effect change both individually and corporately. But there is one more application of words that we must discuss. In this next and final chapter, I want to talk to you about a subject that is the apex of this book, the effective ministry of God's Word.

Chapter Eight

Burden of the Word

If idle words spoken by men can affect their environment and cause changes, can you imagine how much power there is in the ministration of God's Word? The apostle Paul said, *I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ for it is the power of God unto salvation* (Romans 1:16). So then, there is power in the ministry of the Word, and you have to know how to tap into this power.

All that we have been learning in the previous chapters brings us to this very important subject of the ministry of the Word. You need to understand that God has not just called you to be an eloquent speaker. You can quote all the right verses and do somersaults on the pulpit and still fail to be effective unless you get a hold of this truth that I am about to share with you.

Psalm 119, verse 130 tells us that the entrance of God's words gives us light.

Psalm 119:130

The entrance of thy words giveth light ...

That is where the ministry of the Word begins. You see, as a minister of God's Word, you not only need the light of God's revelation and the power to retain this light, but you also need a burden. Yes, there is such a thing as a "burden," which is intimately related to the ministry of the Word. What do I mean by "burden?" I'm glad you asked.

When the prophets of old used to minister the Word of God, they would do it from their burden. Watch what the scripture says:

Habakkuk 1:1

The burden which Habakkuk the prophet did see.

Now, the Hebrew word translated as 'burden' in that passage is *massa*, which refers to a mental desire or a load. Without burden, there is no ministry of the Word. For this reason, a minister of the Word must have a burden.

For those of you that have seen me prophesy, you might sometimes notice that when I approach someone that I am about to minister to, it's as if there is a pull to that person. I am drawn to their issues. As a prophet, I can choose who I want to minister to, but most of the time it's that pull from within that will draw me to you. This is what Prophet Malachi refers to as "the burden of the Word of the Lord."

Malachi 1:1

The burden of the Word of the LORD to Israel by Malachi.

It's a burden. That is the only way I can describe it. But you see, it is the same thing that you need in order to be an effective minister of the Gospel. It doesn't only apply to the prophetic.

Before you stand there to minister, what is it that is driving you? Remember, the ministration of the Word ought to stem from deep inside you. It is a ministry of the Spirit of God through you. The apostle Paul put it this way:

1 Corinthians 2:4

And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.

In other words, when Paul would stand there to minister, what you would witness is the expression of the Spirit of God through him. It is not the same thing as getting excited by a Greek word you found on Google. It is the demonstration of the Spirit and of power. When we talk about the word of God coming out of a Spirit filled child of God, it carries the same power as it would if those words had rolled off the tongue of the master himself. Watch what the scripture says;

Acts 10: 44

While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.

Oh hallelujah! While he yet speaking those that were hearing that message were not just receiving words but there was a ministration of the Spirit.

Notice the scripture says, *the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word*, so this thing was communicated through the word that Peter was preaching. Those that didn't hear him didn't receive anything.

In my church in London, I have experienced these things I'm sharing with you many times, and we have testimonies on video, where just by the ministration of God's Word someone who was sick in their body receives their healing. I mean arthritis and sugar diabetes will check out before I even lay hands on the sick. The laying on of hands will heal the sick, but the effective ministry of God's Word can build faith in your spirit to the extent that you won't even need anything else. The Lord Jesus put it this way:

John 6:63

It is the Spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

I hope you are getting this. He said His words are spirit and life. Hallelujah! That is what I am trying to give you right now. It is a ministry of the Spirit of God, that's why He says, *the Spirit quickeneth*. That word 'quickeneth' means to make alive or to impart life. When you minister from that burden, that is precisely what happens, the Spirit gives life.

Formation of the Burden

We have already seen that the starting point of the ministry of the Word is

light. When that light shines on you, it comes as a sudden flash of revelation that goes away quickly. If your thoughts have been dealt with by the Lord, this light from God will be retained in your mind. Your mind then has the ability to translate this light in your spirit into comprehensible thoughts. Such a shining and fixation becomes that burden we are talking about. Every minister of the Word needs to have a burden, but without light, he cannot have a burden. Neither can he have a burden if the light is not translated into thoughts. Think about it. The revelation that you receive from the Spirit of God when you meditate on the Word is meant to renew your mind. That's why the scripture talks about taking every thought captive.

Again, if the light goes away and only thoughts remain, there is no burden. Burden only comes when there is light plus thoughts. Your thoughts are very important because they determine your emotional state, and emotions are the vehicle by which the anointing is transferred.

We must see before the Lord that without light and revelation, there is no burden. Light alone, however, does not make up a burden. Even after light has been translated into thoughts, there will be no burden if the light goes away and only thoughts remain. A minister can have a burden before the Lord only insofar as light is complemented and retained by translated thoughts.

Let me put it this way. Let's say that you have just learnt that everyone that owns a car can now fuel their car for free at BP. That is the light that has come to you. Now you have that light, but you can still see many people who are struggling to fuel their cars. The light that you have, which is the information that there is free fuel, and the thought of the ones who are struggling because they don't have your light, will create in you the burden to reach the ones that need that message. You need both the light and the thought. This is very important because the function of the Word is to release God's light. The burdens the prophets received could only be released through the Word. If we do not have the Word, our burdens will not be released.

You need to understand that the Word of God is alive. That is what the scriptures tell us in Hebrews chapter 4:

Hebrews 4:12

For the Word of God is living and active. It is sharper than any two edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires.

The Word of God has the ability to transfer to you that emotion and desire of the Spirit, and that's how you get that burden.

The Lord Jesus said something profound in the book of John. Watch what the scripture says:

John 7:38

He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

That is the ministry of the Spirit of God through you to others. *It is not by might nor by power but by My Spirit.*

Releasing of the Burden

Physical burdens are unloaded with our hands. Spiritual burdens are unloaded with the Word. All ministers of the Word have the common experience that thoughts alone are not enough to constitute a message in them. They must have the Word before they can release a message. Thoughts alone cannot lead men to God. If a man only has thoughts and nothing else, his speaking will be confused, and get nowhere, going around in circles as if he were in a maze. But if he has the utterance, the more he speaks, the more he will be released. The prophet of old put it this way:

Jeremiah 20:9

Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak anymore in his name. but his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay.

A burden is something that makes a demand on one's resources, that which has been deposited in you, the light that has come into you. The prophet Jeremiah was under that prophetic impulse and could only find relief at the release of that word. He was full of that word, and it demanded to be spoken

the same way that the words in the pages of this book have been welling up in me and demanded to be penned in this book.

You have to be filled with the Spirit, because this ministry of the Word is a ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 5:18

And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit.

The Lord Jesus said rivers of living waters shall flow through you. Be filled with the Spirit, and this will become much easier because you cannot give what you do not have. That is the reason someone can take one of my messages and preach it word for word and yet the same power that was present when I ministered will not be present when they minister.

Brothers and sisters, we are ministers of the Spirit. **2 Corinthians 3:6**

Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.

Of all the things that I have shared with you in this book, the most important is the power in God's Word that can recreate the human spirit and impart eternal life. That Word is what you have been entrusted with, and what I have given you in this book is a tool to help make you effective in that calling.
